# About

The Riverside Café Gallery is based in a community creative arts centre, the Farnham Maltings. Curated in the busy setting of the Riverside Café, exhibitions showcase artwork from a range of local and national contemporary artists and makers. Usually programmed around a year in advance, the schedule consists of a combination of solo and group shows. This includes invited artists; artists selected after submitting an *Exhibition Proposal Form*; or specially curated exhibitions with a theme and/or coinciding with a festival or event held concurrently at Farnham Maltings.

The Riverside Café Gallery generally holds 12-13 exhibitions every year, with each artist having the opportunity to show work over a 4 week period. The gallery space can usually hang around 12-18 pieces of work, depending on the sizes and each artist should work with the available space to ensure their exhibition fills it. There is no charge to hold an exhibition in the Riverside Café Gallery, however the Farnham Maltings will take a 30% (+VAT) commission on sales made. All artwork sales are taken through the Box Office, and artists will be paid by the Farnham Maltings Finance Department via BACS, post exhibition.

The Riverside Café Gallery is a popular local venue which is in high demand. Works need to be of a professional standard with a high quality finish and suitably presented. Submitted work may fit into a theme or group show coming up, in which case you may be invited to participate in a future group exhibition. Alternatively, your work might be added to a waiting list. Artists are also welcome to submit joint or group proposals, if the works are linked through concept, subject or medium.

If you are looking to exhibit your work at the Riverside Café Gallery, then please register interest by completing an *Exhibition Proposal Form* and sending it to [jackie.kirk@farnhammaltings.com](mailto:jackie.kirk@farnhammaltings.com). All applications will be considered but this will not guarantee you a show, and the Farnham Maltings will be in touch as to whether you have been successful or unsuccessful in your application.
